Sabbatical Announcement – Pastor Perry & Barbara Kallevig

On behalf of our Harvest Church Board, we are pleased to announce that we have made provision for both Pastor Perry and Barbara to take a sabbatical leave during the coming summer months—specifically on Memorial Day, May 29 through Labor Day, September 4, 2017.

Just as a "Sabbath" is a day of rest that takes place every seven days, a "Sabbatical" is a season of rest that takes place every seventh year.

The word, Sabbatical, means "to cease" for a season. It's meant to be a time of rest, reflection, and restoration. A sabbatical is

beneficial for both the pastor and the church. Pastors return from a sabbatical spiritually healthier, better rested, and reinvigorated for ministry.

During Pastor Perry and Barbara's sabbatical, our Harvest Church pastoral staff will provide leadership through the weekdays on our campus—and each Sunday morning our Celebration Services at 8:30, 10:00 & 11:30 am will feature inspiring, anointed ministers who will be sharing the Good News of the gospel!

MISSIONS TASK FORCE MEETING

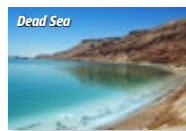
TOMORROW, Monday, May 15, 6:30 pm (Modular 401/402)
