1.	The Power of God's Hand has no weakness or
2.	The Purpose of God's Hand is to act so He alone receives all the (Judges 7:2, Isaiah 42:8, NLT)
3.	The Test of God's Hand refers to withholding His power for His (Luke 7:19, 22–23 NLT).
4.	The Hand of God can be withheld by your (Matthew 13:57–58 NLT)
5.	The Hand of God is always available regardless of the
	(Numbers 14:8-10 NLT, John 19:10-11)
